

Small business grants of up to \$5,000 for businesses affected by COVID-19

The Fresno Area Hispanic Foundation in partnership with the City of Fresno, is providing financial assistance through grants with the purpose of aiding the growth of sales, building capacity and marketing.



Who is Eligible?

Eligible small businesses will need to meet the following criteria to access the grants:

- Be physically located and operating in the City of Fresno
- Have an active business license and be in good standing with the City of Fresno.
- Must have 10 or less employees
- Must demonstrate COVID-19 impact as of March 3, 2021
- Priority will be given to micro small businesses.

Submitted Applications will be subject to a lottery system.

\$5,000 Grants (Brick-and-mortar)

- Restaurants
- Construction trades
- Retail shops
